The Secondary Curriculum will have two main strands:

- Key Stage 3 – building on the foundation formed in Primary
 - Literacy – Oxford Press Read Write Inc – Phonics and Literacy and Writing
 - Numeracy – number skills and furthering development
 - Science – Learning about the body, and healthy eating
 - Art/Music/Food technology /Design technology – exploring real life situations
 - PSHE – looking after myself, helping others and the community

- Key Stage 4 – preparation for adult life and having a functional skill set.
 - Literacy – linking fiction and non-fiction building on Read Write Inc.
 - Numeracy – Number skills in the real world
 - Science – development of our bodies, learning how things interact with each other
 - Art/Music/Food technology /Design technology – making items that are needed in everyday life
 - PSHE – Work Experience and ASDAN certification
